Video formats: VHS, VHS-C, Video 8, Mini DV, reel to reel (8mm and Super 8) (See separate price page for 8mm film)

Videos: Transfer of video to flash drive, external hard drive, or DVD. I now offer **digital downloads** – no cost to customer.


Note: Most transfer services charge by the tape – typically \$20 - \$35 per tape. I charge by the finished minute. Finished minute is determined by the running time of the video <u>after</u> editing. There is a \$10 minimum for tapes under 10 minutes

There are **3 options** to choose from.




Basic Transfer (one to one transfer) \$0.25/finished minute.

This is the typical service offered by online services. It does not include any restoration or enhancements such as color correction. Video issues on original tape will be on the digital copy. Blank sections within tape are <u>NOT</u> removed. This might be an option to choose if you plan on editing your own video.



Edited Transfer \$0.35/finished minute.

This is a step above the typical service offered by online services. Blank sections within the tape are removed. If needed the audio track will be amplified. It does not include any restoration or enhancements such as color correction. This option results in a cleaner quality video.



Enhanced Transfer \$0.45/finished minute.

I edit and improve your videos using **DaVinci Resolve Studio** and vector-scopes. I will brighten and increase contrast and apply basic color correction for sections that need it. Blank sections <u>are</u> removed. I can also apply audio filters to improve soundtrack. The majority of editing services do not offer this kind of service.



Note: Remember, finished minute is determined after editing. So the length of your tape is shorten after editing, which lowers the cost.

If you decide later that you would like one of the basic transfer videos that were previously digitized to be color corrected, I can do that from the mp4 file. I keep copies of all customer videos for one year.

I encourage clients to transfer video to a Flash Drive. Most clients watch the digitized videos on a computer, flat screen TV with USB port, or post it to social media.

If the finished video is intended as a special gift for family and friends, then I can produce a DVD with printed labels and cases. 2 hours of video per DVD.

Note: Tape baking refers to a process to remedy a problem called Sticky Shed Syndrome. The tapes with this problem are usually Ampex (not always). I use a food dehydrator to solve this problem.
